Thank you for your interest in the RAPID Hackathon. BY REGISTERING FOR THE RAPID HACKATHON, PARTICIPATING OR ATTEMPTING TO PARTICIPATE IN THE RAPID HACKATHON AND/OR USING THE RAPID HACKATHON SITE ("Site"), YOU ("you" or "Participant") ARE AGREEING TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS. THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ("**Terms**") ARE A LEGALLY BINDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN YOU AND SPONSOR WITH RESPECT TO THE RAPID HACKATHON. THE HACKATHON IS VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. Sponsor shall have the right to modify these Terms and Conditions at any time, which modification shall be effective immediately upon posting. Part B – GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. HOW TO ENTER

- a. To enter the RAPID Hackathon, Eligible Entrants must follow the Entry Method and provide a RAPID Hackathon Submission during the RAPID Hackathon Period as set out in Part A.
- b. An entry is deemed to be accepted at the time the entry is received by the Sponsor (and not at the time of submission by the entrant).
- c. The Sponsor accepts no responsibility for any lost, delayed, misdirected, undelivered or unreceived entries for whatever reason, including for any technical reason. Proof of delivery of the entry is not proof of receipt by the Sponsor.
- d. There is no entry fee and no purchases are required to enter this RAPID Hackathon.
- e. You can participate either as part of a team of Five (5) people or on an individual basis. Switching teams is not allowed. Sponsor is not responsible for, and will not assist in resolving, any disputes between team members.
- f. To register as a Participant in the RAPID Hackathon you must sign up at the given page/site and indicate you agree to these Terms and Conditions and the Sponsor's Privacy Statement, if any. You will need to provide certain information about yourself to register. If you are registering on behalf of a team, you are representing that all team members have read the Terms and Conditions and Privacy Policy and (1) that you have the authority to bind all team members whom you represent to the Terms and Conditions and Privacy Policy; and (2) that those whom you represent will be bound by and a party to the Terms and Conditions and Privacy Policy. Registrations are limited and are on a first come, first serve basis, and Sponsor and/or Event Management team has the right to end registration or limit the number of registrants at any time in its sole discretion.

2. COLLECTION/USE OF YOUR INFORMATION.

- a. As described in more detail below in these Terms and Conditions, we may

ask you for additional information to confirm that you are in compliance with these Terms and Conditions and/or (if applicable) are eligible to receive prizes. Your failure to provide such information within the requested time frame may render you ineligible. Please see our Privacy clause below for information about how we collect, use and disclose information you provide.

- b. The terms of the Privacy Statement are incorporated by reference into these Terms and Conditions.

3. HOW DO I FORM A TEAM?

A team can include a maximum of 5 Participants (a "Team"). The size of your Team will not be taken into consideration in the judging.

4. VALID ENTRIES

- a. Entries on behalf of another person/team or joint submissions by two separate Eligible Entrants are not allowed.
- b. You may submit up to the Maximum Number of entries as set out in Part A. If you submit multiple entries in excess of the permitted maximum, only the entry or entries most recently submitted (up to the permitted maximum) will be accepted.
- c. Multiple entries (where permitted) must be submitted separately, and each entry must be unique and original.
- d. The Sponsor reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and entrants at any time. This includes requiring an entrant to provide the Sponsor with proof of age, identity and/or residency, using suitable identification as determined by the Sponsor at its sole discretion.
- e. The Sponsor may disqualify any entrant, if the Sponsor considers at its sole discretion, that the entrant has breached any part of these Terms, tampered with the entry process or engaged in any improper conduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper operation of the RAPID Hackathon.

5. HOW TO WIN

- a. The RAPID Hackathon is a game of skill, and chance plays no part in determining the Winner.
- b. All entries will be judged in accordance with the Judging Process and Judging Criteria as set out in Part A, or such other process and/or criteria as notified to you from time to time.
- c. The judges' decision is final and not reviewable and no challenges to the final decision will be considered or accepted.

6. PRIZES AND AWARDS

- a. Subject to applicable laws, the Winner will be awarded the Prizes as set out in Part A (as applicable).
- b. Prizes may be subject to additional terms and conditions.
- c. Prizes are non-transferable and may not be offered for resale, resold, or redeemable for cash.
- d. The Winner is (and the Sponsor is not) responsible for any tax, custom charges or other costs arising from the Prize winnings.
- e. The Winner is required to independently declare and pay any applicable taxes and charges that a Prize may give rise to in the Winner's jurisdiction. Notwithstanding the foregoing, and without prejudice to below, the Sponsor may, where legally required to do so, withhold the Prize (or part thereof).
- f. If for whatever reason a Prize (or any part of it) is unavailable at the time the Winner is announced, the Sponsor reserves the right to substitute any Prize (or any part of it) for an item of similar value. The Sponsor accepts no responsibility for any variation in the value of the Prize (or any part of it).

The Participants whose Entries are awarded the top ten (10) highest scores by the Sponsor's Juries will receive a material prize as mentioned under Prize Section in Part A which will be disclosed on the day of the event. For any cash prizes awarded to a Team involving more than one Participant, each eligible

Participant shall be awarded an equal share of such prize. Once distributed, such equal shares may be redistributed to Team Participants among themselves at the discretion of the Team. Sponsor shall not, in any way, be responsible or liable for such distributions or any actions or inactions relating to such distributions. Except as stated above, Prizes awarded are non-transferable. Non-cash prizes, if any, are not exchangeable for cash. Prizes are subject to any and all additional limitations or restrictions. The ability to offer and provide, and for any Participant to receive, any prize(s) are subject to applicable laws and regulations and to availability (including but not limited to any/all individual or entity donors or prospective donors having provided the relevant prizes and/or prize funding to Event Management team as anticipated). Sponsors will not replace any lost or stolen prizes. Winners are solely responsible for any and all federal/central, state, provincial and local taxes, if any, that apply to prizes.

- i. Sponsor reserves the right to verify the identity and eligibility of all Participants and Teams at any time. Without limiting the general nature of the prior sentence, prior to (and as a condition of) awarding any prizes, Sponsor in its sole and absolute discretion may require additional paperwork to be executed by the relevant Participants following the end of the RAPID Hackathon. Such paperwork is expected to include, among other things, an affidavit and release and will request any necessary information needed for tax reporting purposes. WITHOUT LIMITING THE GENERAL NATURE OF THE PRIOR SENTENCE, AWARDS OF PRIZES TO WINNERS ARE SUBJECT TO THE EXPRESS REQUIREMENT THAT THEY SUBMIT TO SPONSOR ALL DOCUMENTATION REQUESTED BY IT TO PERMIT IT TO COMPLY WITH ALL APPLICABLE STATE, FEDERAL AND LOCAL TAX REPORTING. ALL PRIZES WILL BE NET OF ANY TAXES REQUIRED BY LAW TO BE WITHHELD. TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, ALL TAXES

IMPOSED ON PRIZES ARE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF WINNERS.

- j. Sponsor reserves the right to declare any winners until after Sponsor has received and verified the signed paperwork from the prospective winners. If the prospective winners do not complete, sign and return the required paperwork within seven (7) days of request (unless Sponsor in its discretion agrees to a longer time) or comply with such laws, Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, declare that your prizes have been forfeited and/or select an alternate potential winner.
- k. Sponsor will determine participation eligibility, declare winners (including but not limited to in the event of a tie), and award prizes in its sole and absolute discretion.
- l. You agree that such decisions are final and are not subject to review or reconsideration.

7. HOW WINNER WILL BE NOTIFIED

- a. The Winner will be notified on the date and in the manner as set out in the Winner Notification section in Part A.
- b. If the Prize has not been accepted or claimed within the Claim Period as set out in Part A, the relevant Winner's entry will be deemed invalid, and the Sponsor will, at its sole discretion, redistribute or retain the Prize in the manner as set out in the Unclaimed Prize section in Part A.
- c. The Sponsor will deliver the Prizes in accordance with the Prize Delivery section as set out in Part A.
- d. To the maximum extent permitted, the Sponsor accepts no responsibility for lost, delayed, damaged, undelivered, misdirected, or unreceived Prizes or mail. The Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, re-deliver, re-distribute or retain any undelivered or returned Prize as set out in the Undeliverable Prize section in Part A.

8. PRIVACY

Information to be provided pursuant to Article 13 of, Regulation (EU) 679/2016 (the General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR).

- a. Personal data provided voluntarily will be processed, primarily using electronic methods and analysis tools, including

for statistical analysis, by the Sponsor (and its affiliates) for completion of all stages relating to the RAPID Hackathon. In addition, it will be processed so as to comply with administrative regulations and other general obligations imposed by applicable law and by EU decisions and stored for the period of time established by these regulations. It is obligatory to provide the data requested for the aforesaid purposes and failing to do so will make it impossible to carry out management operations relating to the RAPID Hackathon and to comply with legal requirements.

- b. Subject to their express consent, the Winner's data may be published via communications media, including on the internet, and in informational and promotional material in digital and paper form.
- c. Additionally, subject to your express consent (i) your data may be processed by the Sponsor (and its affiliates) or shared with third parties for the purposes of distributing promotional and marketing information, including sending newsletters, promotions of goods and services, vouchers, surveys and market research (this promotional contact will be made via email, telephone, text message, and/or by post).
- d. Where you have consented to promotional contact (marketing), the data will be stored in the archives of the Sponsor (or its affiliates) for as long as it is considered that there is still an interest in the services about which you requested information, or following the exercise of your rights to object to processing for marketing purposes. In this case also, once the storage period has expired the data will be anonymised to produce statistics, and all identifying data will be destroyed by deleting it from our archives.
- e. The persons authorised for data processing are sales and marketing personnel, call centre staff, and IT systems and data security personnel.
- f. Pursuant to Articles 15-21 of the GDPR, by writing to the Sponsor at their postal address or by email dpo@routemobile.com, you may exercise your rights to consultation, modification, erasure and the right to be

forgotten, the right to restriction of processing or to object to processing on legitimate grounds or for informational and promotional reasons, including via certain means of contact only (e.g. email, landline and mobile phone, text message, by post). If not specific, the objection will be extended to all means of contact. Should you revoke your consent, which you may do at any time, it is understood that this shall not prejudice the legality of processing based on consent previously given or alternative mechanisms of consent provided by law. You also have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory authorities to enforce your rights. Again, by sending an email to dpo@routemobile.com, you may request a full and updated list of those responsible for data processing. The Data Protection Officer can be contacted via email dpo@routemobile.com and/or tel. +912240337690 for information relating to data processing.

- g. Lastly, you have the right to data portability, namely to receive your personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and the right to transmit that data directly to another independent controller, so that the latter may process it within the limits you have set.

9. YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

- a. Each Participant is responsible for its own hardware and/or software they believe they need to participate (e.g. laptops, phones, etc.), including any necessary chargers. Sponsor's or its team, agencies who managing the RAPID Hackathon Event ("**Event Management team**") is not responsible or liable to provide any kind of support or assistance in this regard.

10.YOUR OBLIGATIONS

- a. When participating in the RAPID Hackathon, you must comply with these Terms and all applicable laws and regulations, including intellectual property, privacy, anti-discrimination and criminal laws.
- b. Without limiting the previous paragraph, you must not submit any content or material that: (a) infringes the copyright,

moral rights, privacy rights or confidentiality rights of any third party; (b) contains any virus or other damaging material; (c) is inappropriate, defamatory, abusive, obscene, vulgar, offensive, involves unlawful discrimination, threatens, intimidates or harasses any person; or (d) is otherwise inconsistent with the spirit of the RAPID Hackathon or which is potentially damaging to either the Sponsor or any third party's image or reputation.

- c. You warrant to the Sponsor that: (a) you are eligible to participate in the RAPID Hackathon in accordance with these Terms; (b) you have not and will not breach these Terms; (c) all contents and materials you submitted as part of the entry are original works, and do not infringe any rights (including intellectual property rights) of any third party; and (d) to the best of your knowledge, all details provided with the entry are true and accurate.
- d. A breach of the warranty set out in this section will result in the entry being invalid.
- e. You indemnify the Sponsor (and will keep the Sponsor indemnified) against all losses, damages and costs incurred by the Sponsor arising from or in connection with your breach of the Terms.

11.INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- a. Unless otherwise agreed between you and the Sponsor in writing, you grant the Sponsor a worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free, licence-fee-free, sub-licensable, transferable, perpetual and irrevocable licence to use, copy, store, reproduce, modify, adapt, display, publish, distribute, perform, broadcast, communicate, and exploit the content and materials you submitted as part of your entry (including your name and comments) for any purpose (including promotional, marketing or publicity purposes).
- b. You agree that the Sponsor and its authorised licensees may do (or omit to do) any acts in respect of your content which may otherwise constitute an infringement of your moral rights. Without limiting the foregoing, you agree that the Sponsor may fail to attribute you as the author of the content, and

that the Sponsor may publish an edited or adapted version of your content, for legal, editorial or operations reasons.

12. OWNERSHIP OF ENTRIES

- a. Participant represents and warrants that the Entry does not violate any agreement or obligation to any invention assignment, proprietary information, confidentiality, non-solicitation, noncompetition or similar agreement with any employer.
- b. Participant represents and warrants that the Entry is and will be Participant's own original work and does not and will not infringe the intellectual property or proprietary rights of any third party, including, without limitation, any third-party patents, copyrights or trademarks. Participant hereby agrees not to instigate, support, maintain or authorize any action, claim or lawsuit against the Sponsor, or any other person, on the grounds that any use of a Participant's Entry, infringes any of Participant's rights as creator of the Entry, including, without limitation, trademark rights, copyrights and moral rights or "droit moral." Participant hereby assigns and transfers and agrees to assign and transfer to Sponsor all right, title, and interest in and to Participant's Entry and consequently Sponsor will have all rights to copy, edit, publicly display, publicly perform, broadcast, publish and use, in whole or in part, any Entry, in any manner without further compensation during and after the RAPID Hackathon. At Sponsor's request and expense, Participant will assist and cooperate with Sponsor in all respects to execute documents, and will take such further acts reasonably requested by Sponsor to enable Sponsor to acquire, transfer, maintain, perfect and enforce their intellectual property rights and other legal protections for the Entry.
- c. Participant hereby appoints the officers of Sponsor as Participant's attorney-in-fact to execute documents on behalf of Participant for this limited purpose. Nothing herein shall constitute an employment, joint venture, or partnership relationship between Participant and Sponsor.

- d. Participants will not receive any compensation from Sponsor in connection with any Entries.
- e. Each Participant acknowledges and agrees that Sponsor or other Participants or third parties may have developed or commissioned works which are similar to the Entry of Participant or Participant's team, or may develop something similar in the future, and each Participant waives any claims that Participant may have resulting from any similarities to the Entry of Participant or Participant's team.

13. NO WARRANTY
